THE RETURN OF A LEGEND TO CRANS-MONTANA!

After the confirmation from the winner of the British Open, South African Louis Oosthuizen, the organizers of the OMEGA EUROPEAN MASTERS 2010 can rejoice.

Greg Norman, "The Great White Shark", who for many years was one of the leaders in international professional golf, is returning to the plateau of Crans-Montana. The participation of the charismatic 55 year old in the middle of promising young stars adds a special attraction to the next edition of the Omega European Masters (September 2-5). Today, above all a successful entrepreneur (including golf course design), Greg Norman chooses the tournaments he participates in very carefully. But watch out, he is still capable of extraordinary results: such as the 2008 British Open where he was in the lead after the first 3 rounds and then let go in the final round to finish in 3rd place.

During his 34 year professional career, Greg Norman has won 88 tournaments around the world, but "only" 2 Majors, the British Open in 1986 and 1993. If the gods of golf often abandoned him when it came time to triumph, he has still finished 30 times in the top 10 in major tournaments!

Norman participated several times in the Swiss Open in Crans Montana in the 70s and 80s and his best result was 3rd place in 1980 when he was 25. The last time he participated was in 1995.
