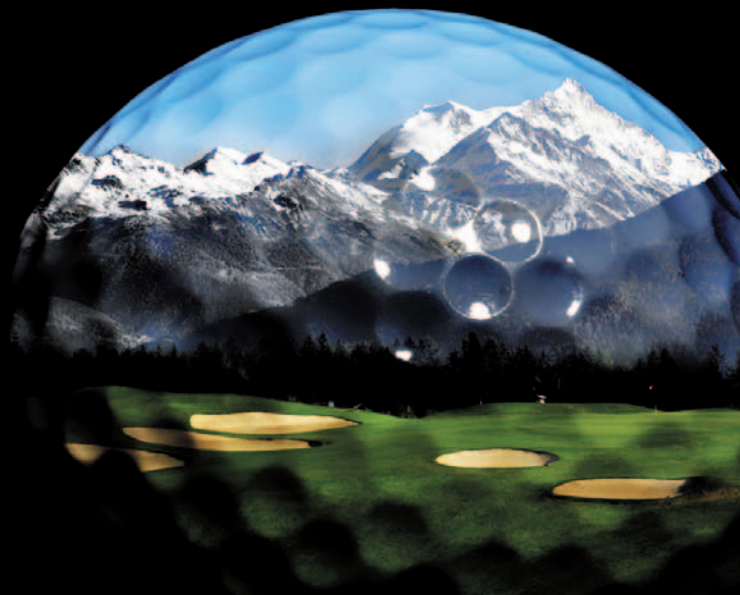

THREE VERY TALENTED PLAYERS PRESENT FOR THE OMEGA EUROPEAN MASTERS

Particularly talented and already looked upon as extremely promising in the world of professional golf, these players will be present at the Omega European Masters 2010 which will take place from 2 to 5 September in Crans-Montana.

For the first time a South Korean is ranked at the top of the world amateur ranking. **Jin Jeong**, 20, won the British Amateur Championship in Scotland on 19 June. Jeong was the first Asian to win in the 125 years of history of this prestigious tournament. This included being able to participate in the British Open which took place one month later and he was brilliant! At St Andrews, in the middle of stars, Jeong finished 14th. It is in Australia that he is preparing his professional career.



Another South Korean, **Seung-yul Noh**, is described as a young prodigy. In his fourth year as a professional he is the current leader of the Asian Tour, and only 19 years old. His titles for the year 2010 include being in the top ten in 13 tournaments! By winning the Maybank Malaysian Open, he beat his opponent and fellow countryman K.J. Choi, his idol who is very successful on the US PGA Tour.



The Italian shooting star, **Matteo Manassero**, is the second youngest player, after Severiano Ballesteros, to evolve on the European Tour. In 2009, at 16, Manassero was the youngest player to win the British Amateur Championship and the youngest player ever to participate in the British Open (finished 13th!). In Crans-Montana, he finished 23rd. In April this year he broke a new record, he was the youngest amateur to pass the cut at the US Masters (36th). Several weeks later, he started his professional career playing in the BMW Italian Open. Not the least bit intimidated, he finished 17th at the BMW PGA Championship in Wentworth which came with a check for 51'423 Euros.
