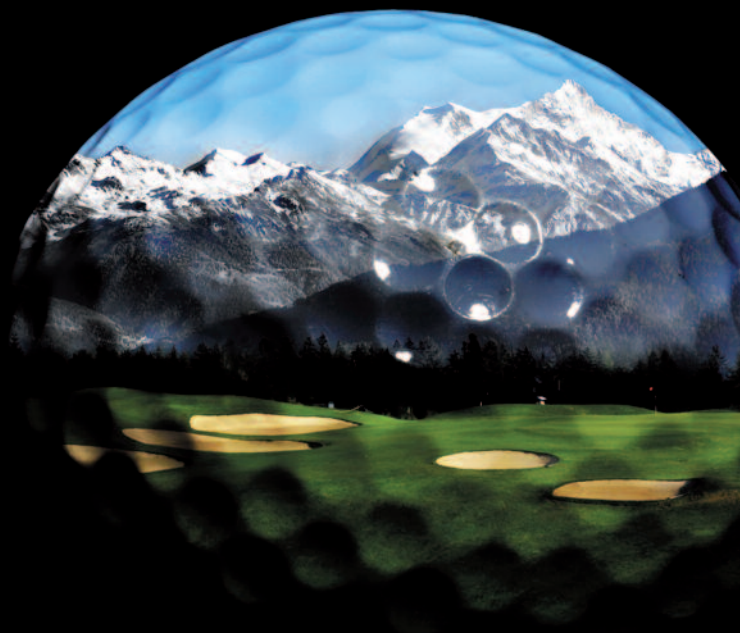

FOR THE 22ND CONSECUTIVE TIME, MIGUEL ANGEL JIMENEZ IS RETURNING TO CRANS-MONTANA

This exceptional player could not miss participating in the Omega European Masters 2010. **Miguel Angel Jiménez**, from Spain, will play for the 22nd consecutive time in Crans-Montana. As each and every year, you can be assured, that he will do his very best to come in first in this tournament and in surroundings that he appreciates very much. He has been in the top ten eight times and came in second place in 1993 and 2004. Through perseverance and his monumental risk taking, Jimenez can be proud of his impressive list of accomplishments: over 500 tournaments on the European PGA Tour and 17 victories, four times in the top five of the annual rankings as well as six times in the top ten in Majors. He is also an excellent team player; Jiménez has proved it in ten Alfred Dunhill Cups and twelve World Cups for Spain, and three Ryder Cups in 1999, 2004 and 2008 with the European team. With his magnificent manner of winning the playoffs of the Omega Desert Classic and the Alstom French Open this year, he is assured of a place in the European team for the Ryder Cup. Jiménez, the man with long curly hair, admits enjoying good red wine, noble cigars and fast cars. He is the only professional player to have won the three BMW tournaments on the European Tour. For a man passionate about cars, he couldn't dream of anything better.

At the end of last week, the organizers of the OMEGA EUROPEAN MASTERS have, unfortunately, had to confirm a cancellation; **Lee Westwood** from the UK. The player, who currently ranks third in the world, is suffering from an injury in his right ankle which started at the beginning of July, during the French Open. During the WGC - Bridgestone Invitational, in Ohio, USA, the pain was so unbearable that he had to abandon. His doctors have advised him to undergo treatment for several weeks and include no playing at all. At this time, it is also possible that his participation in the next Ryder Cup which is to take place from the 1st to the 3rd of October in Wales might be compromised.
